



Qube Open Art Competition is returning in 2019

**An exhibition of shortlisted entries will be held at Qube from
2nd August to 30th September 2019.**

The theme of this year's competition is 'Inclusion'.



Cash prize for the best in show

The People's Choice Prize will be an exhibition at Qube. The winner will be allocated exhibition space in the main Qube gallery in 2020

- The only criteria is that artwork must be on the theme 'Inclusion'. This can be interpreted any way you like.
- The competition is open to all ages.
- Work submitted can be by any medium, for example illustration, textile, sculpture, metal work, watercolour or jewellery.
- Entries can be 2D, 3D or digital.

How to Enter and Conditions of Entry

Entry forms are available from Qube, by emailing art@qube-oca.org.uk or from our website www.qube-oca.org.uk/qubeopen

Artists are required to include an image of the piece(s) they plan to enter into the competition. This image will be used in the selection process and may be used in any marketing.

Entry forms must be completed and returned by **Monday 1st July 2019**.

Artwork submitted must not have previously been exhibited at more than one other gallery.

There is a fee of £10 to enter the competition for each artwork, which is non-refundable. Each artwork may consist of one or more element. Artists may submit more than one piece of work.

The work does not have to be for sale. A commission of 25% (plus VAT on the commission) for any works sold will be taken.

Selection for the Exhibition

The shortlisting judges will consist of members of the Qube Arts Panel and external arts professionals and artists. Successful entrants will be notified by Saturday 13th July. Work selected for the exhibition will need to be delivered to Qube between **Saturday 27th and Wednesday 31st July**. Wall hanging pieces preferably need to be strung or mirror plated Qube reserves the right to refuse works where the quality does not match that indicated in the submitted image.

Exhibition dates are 2nd August to 30th September. All artwork should be labelled on the back with the following information:

- The artist's name
- Title of the artwork
- Either **not for sale** or **for sale**, with full sale price, inclusive of commission and VAT on commission.

You will be expected to sign an artwork loan form for your work on delivery.

The Best in Show winner will be announced at the Exhibition Open Evening on Friday 2nd August

The People's Choice prize is 4 weeks exhibition space in 2020. Dates to be arrange between Qube and competition winner. This prize equates to a total of £300. No cash alternative is offered. Voting takes place throughout the exhibition and the winner will be announced at the end.
