



A COAT OF ARMS MADE OF CLOTHES

You will need:

A pile of clothes, preferably clean!
Choose clothes for their colours and the shapes they can make
Socks are good
So are jumpers, t-shirts, skirts and scarfs



You will also need:

Your imagination!
An image or idea of what you'd like to draw- it could be a landscape, someone's face, a fruitbowl, the list is endless!



1. Think about contrasting and complimentary colours

2. Experiment with the different shapes your clothes can make

You can roll them into a ball
Draw lines with your socks
Colour in with t-shirts and skirts



I made a pattern using blue jumpers and t-shirts and a yellow skirt

It reminded me of Shropshire's Coat of Arms!
